

## Program Allocation Process

State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) (RLP)  
Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP)  
Clean Ohio Conservation Program (COCP)

Available funds each Fiscal Year\* \$175,000,000 (SCIP), \$55,000,000 (LTIP) \$25,000,000 (RLP), \$37,500,000 (COCP). Funds allocated among 19 established Districts or Natural Resource Assistance Councils across the State of Ohio.

Local Government applies to District Public Works Integrating Committee or Natural Resource Assistance Council for particular project(s) identified as subdivision's top priority.

DPWIC or NRAC evaluate and select projects pursuant to a rating and ranking process developed by the DPWIC/NRAC and based on evaluation criteria contained within Chapter 164 of the Revised Code.

Commission staff review DPWIC/NRAC submittal for proper project selection and evaluation methodology.

Commission staff review individual applications for: Project eligibility completeness of application and project financing (grant, loan, credit enhancement). Loan review performed by Loan Officer.

Project specific Project Agreements are executed between the Director of the Ohio Public Works Commission and the Chief Executive Officer of the applicant.

Funds are disbursed during the life of the project. Disbursements are made directly to an authorized contractor(s) or as a reimbursement to the applicant.

Project monitoring activities: electronic compliance, project completion report, and State Audit.
